- > For each exemption sought, a subject outline must be provided, meeting the following criteria. Students should submit the certified copy with the form and retain the originals as a back-up copy.
- > Subject outlines must reflect the year the subject outline is relevant to, and this must be the same year in which the student passed the subject.
- > Outlines must contain details of the topics covered, hours of class time, the method of assessment used and textbooks required. A paragraph from an institution's Calendar/Handbook is not sufficient. Inadequate outlines will not be accepted.
- > Subject outlines must be in English. If subject outlines have been translated to English, they must be stamped as translated by a professional interpreter.
