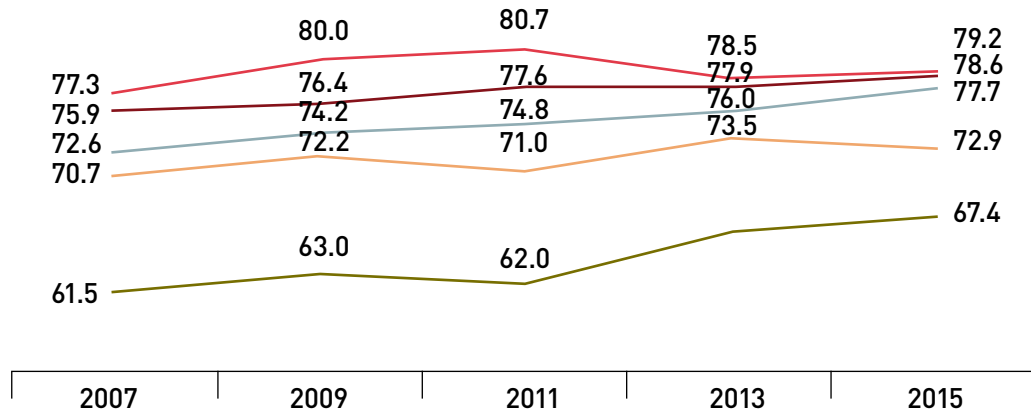
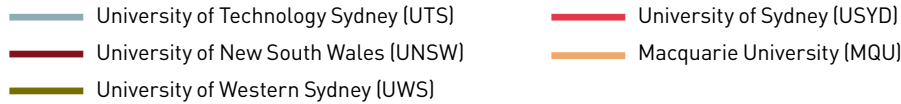

- > USYD remains the most reputable university among the universities in this study, while UWS remains the least reputable
