



UTS Prize Conditions of Award

Gareth Ivory Memorial Prize in Journalism

Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and the University of Technology Sydney ('UTS') about this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. PRIZE NAME: Gareth Ivory Memorial Prize in Journalism

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of the prize is to award the student who achieves the highest WAM within the subject 52647 Professional Project.

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients:

One Recipient from the undergraduate Journalism degree (and combined degrees) will be awarded the prize at the end of each year.

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

The value of the prize for the Recipient is \$500.

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$500 by electronic funds transfer to their nominated bank account.
- A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the FASS prize-giving event.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for this Prize, a candidate must meet all the following criteria:

- Must be enrolled in in an undergraduate Journalism degree or a combined degree.
- Most outstanding student in the subject 52647 Professional Project in the session immediately prior to the selection of the Prize.
- The student must not have completed that subject previously.
- The student must not be studying this subject as part of a second major.

5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA, IN PRIORITY ORDER

The prize will be rewarded to the student who:

- Achieves the highest mark within the subject Professional Project 52647.
- If more than one student scores the highest mark in the subject, the prize will be awarded to the student with the highest overall WAM in the degree.

6. SELECTION

The successful candidate will be recommended by Teaching & Learning Staff and approved by the Dean of FASS or their nominee. The donor will be notified about annual Recipients of the prize.
