Applicants for the Bachelor of Management in Tourism and Hospitality must have successfully completed the Advanced Diploma in Hospitality (Management) at TAFE NSW or the Advanced Diploma in Hospitality Management **and** the Advanced Diploma in Tourism Management from Kenvale College of Tourism and Hospitality Management at credit level or higher.

Applicants for the Bachelor of Management in Tourism and Hospitality are selected on the basis of academic performance only. Personal statements are not considered for this course.
