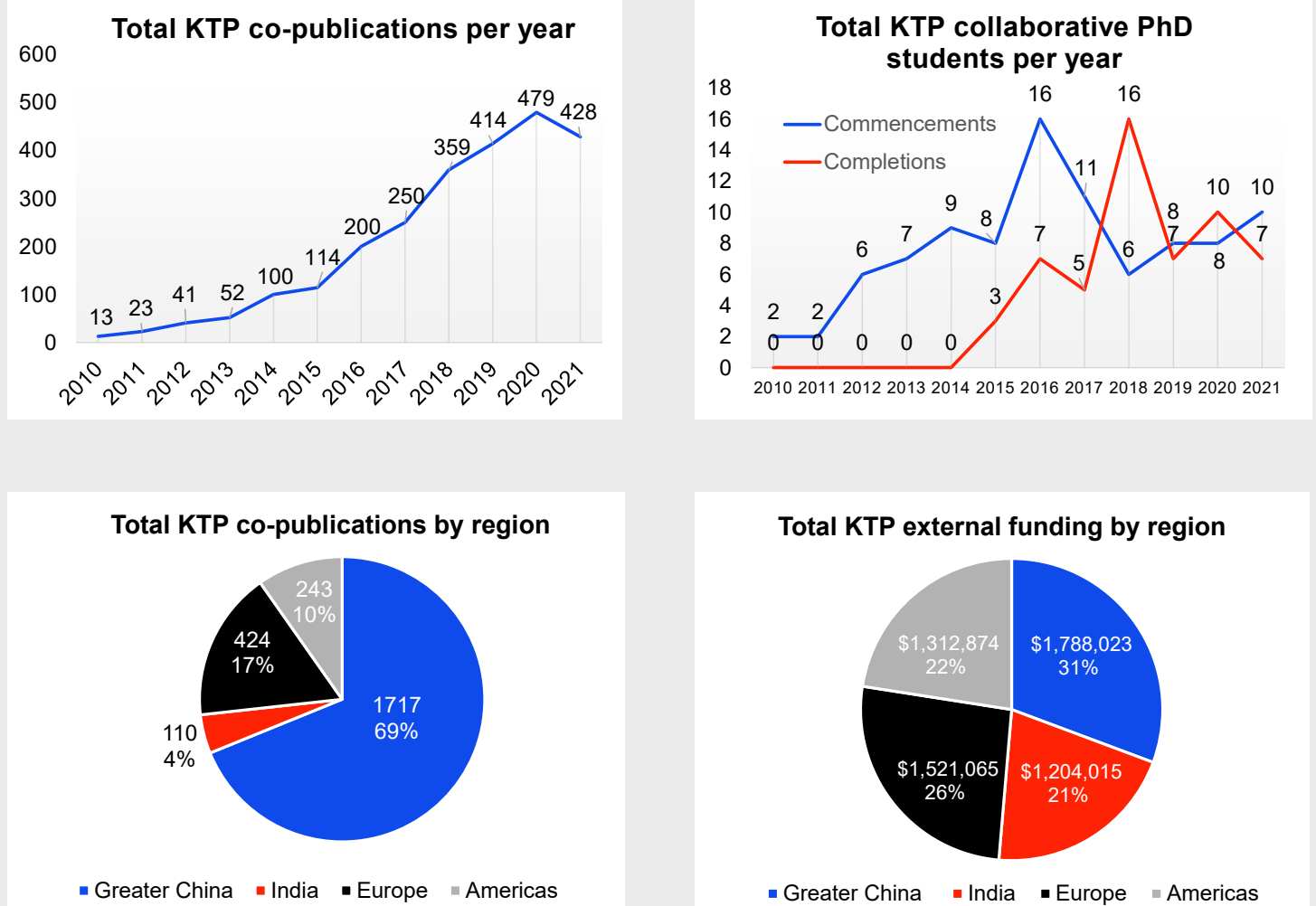

KTP VISITING FELLOW PROGRAM AT UTS

UTS support academic visits that aim to further international research collaboration.

- 2 to 4 weeks visit at UTS
- Grants of up to A\$10,000 towards travel, accommodation, and living expenses
- Administrative support from the KTP team before, during, and after visit.

COLLABORATIVE PHD PROGRAM

A unique opportunity for students to gain international experience by undertaking jointly-supervised research projects at two universities

- Spend one year of the degree abroad at the partner university.
- Apply for tuition fee waivers and living stipend scholarships.
- Achieve formal recognition from both institutions.
