INTRO

Introduction

UTS has opened a call for Letters of Intent (LOI) for the 2025 WUN Research Development Fund. This LOI is only for prospective applications where UTS will be the lead institution.

Research Development Fund

The WUN Research Development Fund (RDF) is an annual competitive fund aimed at bringing together researchers to undertake innovative, high quality, sustainable research that addresses global challenges. The WUN RDF provides grants of up to £10,000 (approx. A\$21,000) for one year to foster research collaborations among academic staff at WUN member universities. UTS will contribute up to A\$5,000 towards each successful UTS application, where necessary and justifiable.

The project must engage at least three WUN member universities (including UTS) in at least two regions. Projects may include non-WUN universities and external partners but must have an active core of WUN member universities. Projects led by early career researchers are especially encouraged.

WUN RDF 2025 Focus

In line with the WUN Strategic Plan 2023-2026, we encourage proposals that address problems in one or more of the following areas within the context of sustainable development:

- 1. Social justice and human rights; inequality
- 2. Sustainable world: cities and urbanization; energy transitions; water, and food security
- 3. Mental health; child and maternal health; ageing
- 4. Responsible and ethical applications of Artificial Intelligence

Application Process

This LOI submission is part of the initial UTS internal review that takes place prior to a formal application submission to the WUN. LOI submission deadline is **Tuesday 2 September 2025.**

The UTS WUN Coordinator will approve two LOIs to develop into full proposals. Applications, submitted online through the WUN online application portal, are due by **11pm AEST on Friday 17 October 2025**.
