Course fees

The UniReady Enabling Program is free, supported by the Australian Government's 'FEE-FREE Uni Ready Courses' initiative. All students in the UniReady Enabling Program will enrol in a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP), which are university places subsidised by the Australian Government. Students won't need to make any student contributions or access HECS-HELP, or pay the Student Service and Amenities Fee (SSAF) for the UniReady Enabling Program. There may, however, be non-tuition fees and other expenses associated with studying.

Privacy


