

APPROVED RULE CHANGE

Schedule 1 — Definitions

. . .

Graduate Research School Board means the group of staff and students with responsibility for assessing the quality of, and providing direction to, the administration of graduate research education in the Graduate Research School. Under Rule 1.3 of the Student Rules, the Graduate Research School Board (GRSB) is accountable for making strategic decisions to shape the direction and practices of the Graduate Research School in matters of students, research and teaching, its development and its core business as a paninstitutional entity.

Higher Degree Research Committee <u>Graduate Research School Board</u> means the body appointed by Academic Board to provide recommendations and advice on matters relating to graduate research training quality and performance, degree accreditation and removal, research integrity and emerging trends in graduate research.
