## USE YOUR YEAR 11 RESULTS TO ENTER UTS

### Eligibility

- Be a current domestic or international onshore Year 12 student
- Complete the Year 12/NSW HSC equivalent exams
- Meet the matriculation requirement of at least 69 ATAR and 70 for Education courses


### Applying

- Apply through the UTS online application portal (this is different to UAC)
- It is free to apply and you only need to apply once
- Applications are open and close 12 September

### Offers

- Offers will be made on your preferences and based on your Year 11 results
- Offers will be released on 5 October before the HSC commences!
- You will be able to enrol in your UTS course in December upon meeting the ATAR requirement.

# Engineering and IT Early Entry Program - EDGE

You'll be assessed using your Year 11 results *plus* Edge Points.

## Key Dates:

**10 August 2021:** Applications open

**12 September 2021:** Applications close

**5 October 2021:** Conditional offers released

Edge points are made up of the following:

### Your Edge Portfolio

- Tell us why you are passionate about Engineering and IT by answering four questions
- Maximum 8 points
- Note: the same portfolio will also count towards your adjustment points in the UAC rounds

### Women in Engineering and IT Initiative

- 10 points will be counted towards your EDGE points if you're eligible for this scheme

### Year 11 Subject Grades

- High school grades in selected STEM subjects = more EDGE points
- No need to submit your grades
- Maximum 5 points

Edge point cap = 13 points



# Frequently Asked Questions

# Why did UTS introduce the Early Entry Program?

- ✓ Reward students for their hard work and academic achievements during Year 11.
- ✓ We also recognise that the impact of COVID-19 has been quite substantial on this cohort, so we want to make sure they have as many opportunities as possible to get into University.

# **What is the ATAR requirement for unconditional offers?**

- ✓ Similar to all students who apply to UTS, unconditional offers will be based on meeting the UTS matriculation requirement of an ATAR of at least 69 and 70 for Education courses.

# **What do Careers Advisers and Teachers need to do?**

- NSW/ACT HSC = no need to provide further information
- IB = A school report can be provided if it has an overall subject grade in 1-7 grade scale. Semester 2/End of year report is required
- Interstate qualifications = Year 11 Results Form

# **What is the difference between the early entry program and SRS (access)?**

- ✓ The UTS Early Entry Program is a merit scheme and focuses on rewarding students who have performed well in Year 11 and this is reflected in their Year 11 results
- ✓ The SRS Access Stream focuses on supporting students that may not have been able to show their best potential in their HSC due to the disruption to studies caused by COVID-19

## **Why are some courses not included in the Early Entry Program (specifically law, health and Co-op Scholarships)?**

- ✓ Health and Law courses: Due to the competitive nature for these degrees, they are not included in the UTS Early Entry Program in 2021
- ✓ Co-op Scholarships: The Co-operative scholarships at UTS have a different application process than normal courses. They require a written application and interview

# **With the changes to HSC dates, have the Early Entry Program dates changed?**

- ✓ Yes, our unconditional offers are now being released on 18 December, one day after ATARs are released
