



VACCINATION CHECKLIST



Check this upon enrolment!

Hepatitis B (Hep B)

An age-appropriate course of vaccinations for students AND a copy of laboratory serology test results minimum 4 weeks after last vaccination dose.

OR

Appendix 9: Hepatitis B Declaration Form AND a copy of laboratory serology test results minimum 4 weeks after last vaccination dose.

i If required, it takes 5 months to complete a 2nd course!

See Vaccination Schedule for students:

0, 1, 4 months then serology test MIN 4 weeks after

OR

0, 2, 4 months then serology test MIN 4 weeks after

Check your Immunisation History Statement AND

Vaccination Record Card must have clinic stamp, full name and signature at every entry completed by GP

MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella)

An age-appropriate course of vaccinations (0 & 1 months) OR a copy of laboratory serology test results.

Varicella (Chickenpox)

An age-appropriate course of vaccinations (0 & 1 months OR one dose if vaccinated < 14 years of age) OR a copy of laboratory serology test results.

(ACT don't accept one dose - Genetic Counselling only)

Influenza (Flu)

Required if you are attending placement June - September. Available from March annually, only current year vaccination strain accepted.

dTpa (Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis)

Vaccination must be administered within the last 10 years. Must be dTpa. ADT not accepted.

Working With Children's Check

Apply for a NSW Volunteer Working with Children Check (WWCC) via Service NSW. If completing a placement outside of NSW, you may also need to apply for a WWCC or equivalent in that state

Mask Fit Test

Students must obtain an NSW Mask Fit test prior to undertaking a hospital placement. Fit Test Australia [here](#) using the coupon code "FTAUTS2024!" for a UTS student discount. The Mask Fit Test are valid 12 months.

To complete in MyPlacement

- Inherent Requirements Form
- Permission to Disclose Form
- Consent to Student Register AHPRA Form (*Clinical Psychology and Physiotherapy only*)
- Upload evidence of AHPRA Provisional Registration (*Clinical Psychology only*)

First Aid & CPR Certificates

Not required for Clinical Psychology or Genetic Counselling

Students must obtain both First Aid and CPR certificates (must be valid for the duration of your course).

- HLTAID011 Provide First Aid [Valid for 3 years]
- HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) [Valid for 1 year]

To receive a discounted rate, UTS students can submit an enquiry via the Contact Us page and mention that they were referred by UTS. This will allow them to access the following rates:

- HLTAID011 First Aid: \$90
- HLTAID009 CPR: \$45 (for those who already have a first aid certificate but need to renew their CPR)

An online course is available for students to complete modules at their own pace. After completing the online modules, students can book a date for the physical assessment, which takes approximately 5 minutes per assessment. Assessment locations are available at Neutral Bay or Gordon Library.
