Eligibility

- Students must have completed a degree in the relevant discipline area in which the Honours degree is to be awarded. Admission also requires the approval of the relevant head of school.
- If your previous studies were not conducted in English, you must submit evidence demonstrating English
 proficiency. For entry to honours courses, UTS accepts results from IELTS (Academic module), TOEFL or
 Pearson tests. These results are valid for two years from the date of completion of the test. For details on
 required test results contact the UTS Student Centre. An offer of admission will not be made until
 proficiency in English is demonstrated.

Note: Applicants who do not satisfy the above criteria will not be considered.

Your application is considered in order of your preference/s so you should select these carefully as you will only receive one offer. If you wish to change your course preference/s after you have lodged your application you should advise the Student Administration Unit in writing and your application will be amended accordingly.

Completing the Application Form

The following instructions relate to the numbered sections on the application form:

Section 2 - Personal Details

If your family name or given names are different from that stated on any documents submitted, you must:

- indicate your previous name(s) in the space provided
- provide proof of name change e.g. certified copy of a Marriage Certificate, Divorce Order, Deed Poll

Section 3 - Choice of Courses

- Indicate which course/s you are applying for in order of preference
- Attendance mode is usually Internal (on campus), however Block mode may be available for selected courses. Check availability on pages 3 4

Section 4 - Citizenship/Residency

• If you do not currently hold Australian or New Zealand citizenship or Australian permanent residency then you must apply as a full-fee paying International student on a different application form. Contact UTS: International on 9514 1531

Section 5 - Secondary Studies

• If you have completed an Australian Year 12 qualification (or overseas equivalent) you need to complete this section. This is required for government reporting purposes

Section 6 - Academic Qualifications

- If you list any academic qualifications here you will need to provide a full academic transcript showing the subjects studied, the marks obtained and an explanation of the grading system. If you have completed the qualification you will need to provide proof of completion
- If any of your qualifications are not in English you will need to provide an official translation **as well as** the original language documents. For example, documents translated by a professional level translator accredited by the National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters (NAATI) are accepted. (See www.naati.com.au for details.)
- Previous UTS students do not need to provide evidence of UTS study

Certification of Documents

- Documents **cannot** be returned once they have been submitted. It is recommended that you submit certified copies, **not** originals.
- Uncertified photocopies and faxed or scanned documents will not be accepted.
- Photocopies of electronic transcripts from other institutions will only be accepted when they can be verified as authentic through an online secure portal hosted by the institution (this often involves submitting a link and password to UTS)
- You **cannot** certify your own documents, even if you belong to one of the categories listed below, and you **cannot** have your documents certified by a person directly related to you.
