

Study Abroad and Exchange at UTS: Design, Architecture and Building (DAB)

As a Study Abroad or Exchange Student, you may design a program of subjects from more than one faculty at UTS, provided you enrol in 24 credit points of full-time study.

Whilst most DAB subjects are 6 credit points each, a number of subjects are 12cp. In other faculties at UTS, subjects are offered at different credit point levels, so ensure that you satisfy the credit point requirements when choosing your subjects.

When can I study?

Study abroad and exchange is available:

- 1) March – July (Autumn Semester) **A**
- 2) July – November (Spring Semester) **S**

Please note:

- In Australia, **Autumn** occurs in the first half of the year. **Spring** occurs in the second half of the year.
- If you apply for a subject with one or more prerequisites, you will need to demonstrate that you have the prior skills and knowledge necessary to undertake the subject. Most subjects are only offered in one semester.
- Undergraduate students are not normally permitted to study postgraduate subjects
