Study abroad and exchange is available:

- 1) March – July (Autumn Semester) **A**
- 2) July – November (Spring Semester) **S**

Please note:

- In Australia, **Autumn** occurs in the first half of the year. **Spring** occurs in the second half of the year.
- If you apply for a subject with prerequisites, you will need to demonstrate that you have the prior skills and knowledge necessary to undertake the subject.
- Most Business subjects are offered in both sessions, except where indicated **A** or **S**. Please check the timetable in case of a change
- Undergraduate students are not normally permitted to study postgraduate subjects
- Some Sport and Exercise Science and Management subjects are offered at [UTS Moore Park precinct](#) the campus is connected to the City Campus by a free shuttle bus during peak periods.
