As a C&S Engineer Intern at Meinhardt (Thailand) Ltd., I contributed to a portfolio of projects in the private sector. At the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction, I helped manage the planning and implementation of the 7th Asian Ministerial Conference on DRR, where I personally engaged with a multitude of stakeholders from ministers to representatives of grassroots organisations. I then wrapped up my NCP program as a Team Leader in the 5th iteration of the Australian-Thai Youth Ambassadors Program, in my pursuit to inspire young leaders and continue to strengthen Australia’s partnerships across Asia. 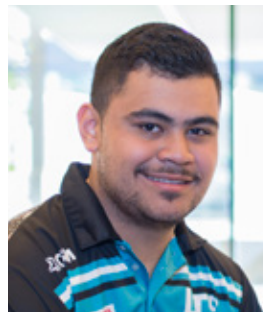


SAFA RAHIMI,

In September 2000, a then seven-year-old Safa Rahimi flew into Sydney Airport. The Rahimi family (which includes four daughters and one son) had spent the last eight years living in Pakistan after fleeing Afghanistan. “Thinking back on it,” recalls Rahimi, “coming here was very, very shocking. It was so different from what we had experienced in Pakistan. We didn’t know where to begin or what to do.” Rahimi and her family, with help from her father’s brother, settled in Western Sydney. Her mother, a paediatrician, stayed home to raise the children while her father, an optometrist, went back to work. Fast forward to 2011 and Rahimi began studying social inquiry and law at UTS. “My parents, at that stage, were retired and I didn’t want to rely on them financially, so I started working quite long hours.” By early 2015, Rahimi was not only studying full-time, but working part-time in the personal injury department of a private law firm, working weekends at Officeworks, interning at Immigrant Women’s Speakout Association and volunteering at the Australian Refugee Volunteers. “It did take a toll on my mental health and also my physical health,” admits Rahimi. “So I thought I should probably get some help.” With encouragement from a friend, Rahimi applied for the UTS Alumni Scholarship and her application was successful. “It was just a massive weight off my shoulders,” she reveals. Not only did the scholarship help Rahimi pay for text books and reading materials, but “it made me step back from work for a while and just concentrate on uni.” She was even able to undertake an additional teaching session for honours in law.

The Jumbunna Institute for Indigenous Education and Research supports the academic, social, cultural and emotional wellbeing of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students at UTS. Our vision is to create a place where all Indigenous Australians can access education and be supported to succeed. Indigenous student Joel Cama considered dropping out of a degree in International Studies because he wasn't sure he could afford it.

"Moving from Lithgow to Sydney was a big wake-up call for me," he says, "My parents aren't that well off... and it can be challenging for many students to keep financially afloat."

Joel now receives a scholarship from UTS, and he is quick to recognise the transformative effects it has had on his life. "As soon as I got it, every worry just dropped and I could focus on what I needed to do. I'm nowhere near as stressed," he says.

Importantly, Joel can also see how the scholarship has given him a clearer vision of what he wants to achieve. "I want to work in elite sport," he explains. "I want to use sports as a platform to correct social injustices. Someone once told me that we're getting help now so that we can help others later on. I'm 100 per cent behind that."

It was then that she applied for and was accepted to receive the inaugural Law Equity Scholarship at UTS.

'We all did a dance around the house. It was such a relief. My life would have been very different had I not received the Law Equity Scholarship'. Alison believes that she couldn't have achieved everything she's done without it, including graduating with first class honours. During her time at UTS: Law she set-up the Indigenous Collective which provides support and advice to Indigenous students on campus. This is when she realised the importance of the balance between law and her Aboriginal community. "The UTS Law Equity Scholarship made my undergraduate study possible, for one. It bought essentials for study and living in the first four years of my undergraduate coursework."

International Students

UTS has committed A\$30 million towards a range of scholarships and grants for commencing and current undergraduate and postgraduate students from 2016 – 2020. A diverse range of scholarships are available for commencing international students, including:

- Academic Excellence Awards – grants of \$10,000 (undergraduate) and \$5,000 (postgraduate) awarded to international students enrolling in UTS coursework programs.
- UTS:INSEARCH Graduate Scholarship – grants awarded to high-achieving UTS:INSEARCH graduates starting at UTS.
- Full Tuition Scholarships – available for international undergraduate and postgraduate coursework students starting at UTS in Autumn and Spring sessions 2018.
- Study Abroad Excellence Awards for commencing Study Abroad students, who are coming to UTS as part of their home degree.
- Government and externally funded scholarships and loans are also available to incoming international students.

UTS Global Exchange

The UTS Global Exchange program allows students to study overseas for one or two teaching sessions at a UTS partner university. With over 240 exchange partners in over 40 countries and territories, UTS has one of the largest international exchange programs in Australia.

UTS and the Australian Government offer scholarships and grants to help cover some of the costs associated with overseas study. Additional funding options are available for students who undertake studies in Asia and the Indo Pacific.

UTS Scholarships and Grants:

- Australian Government Scholarships and Grants

FAQs

WHICH SCHOLARSHIPS AM I ELIGIBLE FOR?

To determine whether you can apply for a particular scholarship, you need to consider your individual circumstances against the specific eligibility criteria of the scholarship.

Key eligibility criteria to look for are:

- Future or current student?
- Your Faculty and/or course?
- Undergraduate or postgraduate?
- Academic merit (see below)?
- Do you meet any of our Equity criteria (see below)?
- Indigenous Australian?
- Elite athlete?

ACADEMIC MERIT

For future students - this is determined based on your High School results (ATAR or equivalent), or if applicable, results from prior studies at TAFE or an undergraduate degree at another institution.

For continuing students - this is determined based on the results obtained so far in subjects from your current degree at UTS.

EQUITY CRITERIA

Scholarships with an Equity component are for students who may be encountering additional challenges in accessing tertiary education or who are experiencing other educational barriers which make it difficult to succeed at university.

Equity criteria can include:

- Students experiencing financial hardship*
- New students relocating from a regional and remote area
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students
- Students from a refugee background
- Students with a long term disabilities or medical conditions
- Sole parents and carers

It is important to note that for many equity-based scholarships you are required to submit an Equity Scholarship application through the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC). It is a free online application which will allow you to be considered for all applicable UTS Equity Scholarships, and can be completed at any time prior to the UTS Scholarship closing date.

*As a rough guide, you are considered to be experiencing financial hardship if you are receiving a means -tested income support payment via Centrelink.

DO I NEED TO APPLY?

In most cases, yes you will need to submit a written application to be considered for a scholarship. However, for a small number of scholarships, Recipients are selected based on student data, such as your ATAR.

When an application form is optional, we highly recommend submitting the scholarship application to give yourself a competitive edge.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Most UTS Scholarships have an online application form on our website which can be completed in your own time from home. Some scholarships require you to complete more than one form, and if you are applying for an equity-based scholarship you will need to also apply through the UAC Equity Scholarship application process.

WHEN DO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS OPEN / CLOSE?

Scholarship opportunities will open and close throughout the year depending on availability and the academic calendar. Future student scholarship will generally require an application to be submitted before ATARs are released in December each year.

ARE SCHOLARSHIPS DEPENDENT ON ME ENROLLING IN A SPECIFIC COURSE?

Scholarships will either be university-wide, meaning that you can be enrolled in any Faculty across the university, or can be course-dependent and require enrolment in a specific course or discipline area (i.e. mechanical engineering, physics, law etc.)

For course-specific scholarships, you can only be considered for the scholarship if you have the relevant enrolment, or for future students, relevant UAC course application. It is also important to check if you are required to remain enrolled in a specific course area to continue receiving payments, or if course transfers are allowed.

ARE HSC BONUS POINTS TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION IN SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION?

For most commencing student scholarships with a specific ATAR cut off, HSC bonus points are not taken into consideration, only your ATAR (or equivalent) is used.

HOW WILL I FIND OUT IF I HAVE BEEN AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP?

If you have applied for a scholarship, either UAC or the UTS Scholarships Office will contact you to advise you of the outcome. Applicants will be notified after the selection process has been completed, generally 4-6 weeks from the time of the application closing date.

IF I AM OFFERED A SCHOLARSHIP, CAN I DEFER IT?

Unfortunately, unlike a course offer, scholarship offers cannot be deferred. However, if you would like to take a gap year or have planned leave from your studies you may be able to apply in the following application round. Check your scholarship for more details.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO ENSURE I KEEP MY SCHOLARSHIP?

Nearly all scholarships have strict ongoing eligibility requirements, often related to maintaining a full-time study load and maintaining a certain academic standard.

All information regarding your scholarship is available in the Conditions of award provided to you in your Letter of Offer. If your study circumstances change, please contact the Scholarships Office for further advice.

CAN I HOLD MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP SIMULTANEOUSLY?

In most cases no, however some exceptions apply if an equity scholarship is approved based on exceptional circumstances. Please check the specific Conditions of Award at the time of offer.

WHAT IF I AM UNSUCCESSFUL IN OBTAINING A SCHOLARSHIP?

Future student scholarships can be extremely competitive.

If you are unsuccessful for a future student scholarship, there are also plenty of opportunities for current students at UTS. You can apply for scholarships throughout your studies depending on what stage you are at in your degree.
