WORKSHOP: Working with a professional stage manager, participants in this design-thinking workshop will learn how to stage a story with lights and sound made from everyday items. Utilising performance, as well as mechanist and technician skills, the day will include dramatic storytelling, innovating theatrical affects, operating basic light and sound equipment and a 'cueing exercise' to culminate in a live performance.



FACILITATOR: Nicola Sinclair is a graduate from the Mountview Academy of Theatre Arts, London. She has toured Shakespeare, thrillers, comedy and theatre-in-education shows across UK and Europe and recently completed a NSW season of Jane Harrison's *Stolen* for the National theatre of Parramatta. She has been a stage manager for the Sydney Opera House since 1999 and in 2013 completed a PhD investigating theatre poetics.
