

## **Information Session Check List for admission to the Graduate Diploma in Midwifery Autumn**

### **General Documentation Requirements:**

1. An official academic transcript or record of study (note: transcripts printed from institution websites will not be accepted. UTS students do not have to provide this.)
2. Evidence of completion of study if this is not stated on the academic record (note: UTS students do not have to provide this)
3. Evidence of name change if applicable
4. Translations of any documents not in English by an accredited authority
5. A brief CV including details of roles performed in current and previous health care employment

### **Course Specific Requirements:**

- Evidence of current registration as a nurse with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (this can also be verified online if the applicant does not have a current hard copy available)
- Concurrent employment as a student midwife is a requirement for entry to the Graduate Diploma in Midwifery. (Note: The employment application process is run by NSW Health and is entirely independent of the university application process).
- Applications for postgraduate student midwifery training positions available in 2020 will open on **Friday 7 June 2019 at 10am** and close on **Thursday 20 June 2019 at 10am**.

### **Notification of Outcome:**

- Applicants who fulfill academic and employment requirements for entry into the course will receive a **conditional letter of offer for study in Autumn 2020** from UTS.
- You should receive notification of employment outcomes in late October 2019. Please email evidence of acceptance of your concurrent employment to [Health.Academic.Programs@uts.edu.au](mailto:Health.Academic.Programs@uts.edu.au) as soon as it becomes available in order to complete your course application.
- We will advise you accordingly by mail regarding your eligibility for an official offer into the course a few weeks after your course application is complete.
