



# UTS Prize Conditions of Award

## Teachers Mutual Bank Rural Student Placement Prize

### FACULTY OF ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and University of Technology Sydney ('UTS') in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

#### **1. PRIZE NAME: Teachers Mutual Bank Rural Student Placement Prize**

#### **2. PURPOSE**

To recognise and encourage students to undergo a rural placement in their third-year of study in the undergraduate teacher education degree.

#### **3. VALUE AND BENEFIT**

##### **3.1 Number of Recipients:**

- Two (2) Recipients annually.

##### **3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:**

- Each Recipient will receive \$1,000.

##### **3.3 Payment of benefit/s:**

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$1000 by electronic funds transfer to their nominated bank account.
- A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences prize giving event.

#### **4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Must have successfully completed a previous professional experience placement in the first and second years of study.
- Must be participating in a rural or remote placement as identified by the UTS School of International Studies and Education placement team.
- Must be in their third year of study (completed a minimum of 96 Credit Points) and eligible for graduating from the undergraduate teacher education degree.

#### **5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA, IN PRIORITY ORDER**

- The Prize will be awarded to the students who
  - have received the highest cumulative mark (GPA) in the first and second years of the undergraduate degree. In the event that two or more eligible students have the same GPA a Selection Committee will select the Recipient(s) based on the top students' Professional Experience reports to determine the recipient(s) of the Prize.

## **6. SELECTION**

- The Prize recipient will be selected by the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.
- In the event a Selection Committee is required, it will include:
  - Director of Professional Experience in the School of International Studies and Education or their nominee,
  - School of International Studies and Education Academic working in the Engagement/School Partnerships portfolio or their nominee, and
  - A professional staff member from the Professional Experience Team
  - A professional staff member from Teaching and Learning Support Team
- The Recipient will be approved by the Dean of the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.
