ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to this course need to meet the following requirements:

- postgraduate qualification at Australian Qualifications Framework Level 8 in nursing
- current registration as a nurse in Australia
- a minimum of two years' full-time equivalent (FTE) as a registered nurse in a specified clinical field and two years' FTE of clinically based advanced practice in the same clinical field
- concurrent employment in, or access to, the chosen/relevant clinical area of study
- evidence of confirmed support to complete all professional experience requirements of the course, including integrated professional practice and supervision in accordance with NSW MoH policy: PD2020_034
- verification of advanced practice, supporting documentation
- demonstration of Clinical Support team, supporting documentation
- evidence of active involvement in professional organisations and contribution to the ongoing development of the profession
- English language proficiency and communication skills to successfully undertake academic experience and integrated professional practice requirement throughout the program.

Applicants must complete and submit the Master of Nurse Practitioner supporting documentation forms with their application and an employer statement of support form.

HOW TO APPLY

Submit your application for a postgraduate by coursework degree online via uts.edu.au/pg-admissions.

Applications should include:

- a certified copy of all relevant academic transcript(s)
- Statement of Service on official letterhead confirming employment
- a completed CSP Personal Statement Application
- a CV to demonstrate advanced practice and professional achievements
- any other relevant supporting documentation.
