How to register

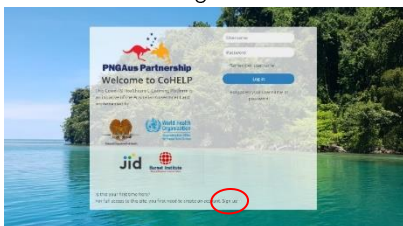
So you are interested in CoHELP? Great! All you have to do to register is:

Have access to a smartphone, computer, laptop or tablet. This could be a personal device or you can ask your workplace to use the devices there.

Type this URL into your favourite internet browser

You should now see this log in screen:



To register click the "Sign Up" link which has been circled in the picture and follow the prompts.

Once you have filled out your participant information you will be directed to the course page! That's it!
