Pursuant to clause 47 in chapter 4 of the By-law, the following rules made by the Vice-Chancellor take effect on 30 July 2001.

## **RULES MADE BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR**

In accordance with By-law (Chapter 4, clause 47) I amend existing Rule 3.4.4.2 – *Rules relating to Students enrolled in particular award courses* as follows (deletions struck through, additions in bold):

## Rule 3.4.4.2

- (a) The maximum time allowed for a candidate to complete a Master's degree by thesis program is four-three semesters in the case of a full-time candidate and six five semesters in the case of a part-time candidate, unless special permission for an extension of time is granted by the University Graduate School Board.
- (b) A Master's degree by thesis candidate who wishes to extend his/her candidature after registration needs to seek permission from the University Graduate School Board for an extension of his/her candidature.
- (c) An extension of maximum time granted by the University Graduate School Board shall not include periods of approved leave of absence and shall not exceed six <u>four</u> semesters in the case of a full-time candidate and <u>nine six</u> semesters in the case of a part-time candidate.
