

Pursuant to Clause 48(1) and (2) in Division 3, Chapter 4 of the By-law, the following rules made by the Vice-Chancellor will take effect on 19 November 2001.

## RULES MADE BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR

In accordance with the By-law (Chapter 4, clause 47), I amend existing Rule 1.2.2 (UTS: Calendar 2001, page 246) of the *Rules of the University Relating to Students*.

The rule would be amended as follows (additions in bold):

- i. In these Rules:
  - (b) 'Responsible Academic Officer' means a person appointed as such by the Vice-Chancellor or the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic) on the advice of the Dean and such other persons as the Vice-Chancellor approves;
  - (c) 'Teaching Period' means Autumn semester, Spring semester, Summer session, or any other Teaching Period approved by the Vice-Chancellor; and 'semester means Autumn semester or Spring semester;
  - (d) A reference to a 'Faculty' 'Dean' and 'Faculty Board' shall be taken to include a reference to such other organisational units, positions and University bodies as the Vice-Chancellor designates in writing. The Vice-Chancellor may make such designation for the purpose of specific rules, groups of rules, or these rules generally.
