



## **UTS Prize Conditions of Award**

### **Guy Morrison Prize for Excellence**

#### **Jumbunna Institute for Indigenous Education and Research**

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and the University of Technology Sydney ('UTS') in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

#### **1. PRIZE NAME: Guy Morrison Prize for Excellence**

**2. PURPOSE:** To recognise outstanding achievement by an Indigenous Bachelor (Honours) or Masters student in their coursework/project work.

#### **3. VALUE AND BENEFIT**

**3.1 Number of Recipients:** One Recipient will be awarded the Prize each year in the Spring session.

#### **3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:**

- The Recipient will receive a cash prize of \$4,000
- The Recipient will also receive a framed Certificate of Award

#### **3.3 Payment of benefit:**

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$4,000 by electronic funds transfer to their nominated bank account

#### **4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- To be eligible for the Prize, a candidate must meet all of the following criteria:
  - Be an enrolled student in any Bachelor (Honours) or Masters degree program in the academic year of the selection of the Prize
  - Be identified and recognised as an Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
  - Have a Weighted Average Mark (WAM) of 65 or above

#### **5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA:**

- Applicants must submit a 500-word outline of their coursework/project work, to be submitted via Jumbunna.
- Students who are not previous UTS students will need to provide a copy of their transcript with their written piece.

**6. SELECTION:** A selection panel will evaluate student applications. The selection panel will be led by the Director, Indigenous Students & Community Engagement, Jumbunna Institute for Indigenous Education &

Research with participation from Jumbunna Institute, and the Graduate School of Research. The donor or their representative will be invited to sit on the panel.

**7. OTHER CONDITIONS:** The Recipient will send a written acknowledgement to the donor upon receipt of the Prize.
