

WELCOME TO YOUR NEW OFFICE BINS

As part of the UTS Cleans Up initiative, all kitchens (and some common areas) in Building 10 now have new bins.

You will need to sort your waste into these bins. By doing so you are helping UTS to reduce waste and save resources. You are also raising awareness about what can be recycled.



FOOD ORGANICS BIN

Place all food waste in this bin, including:

- Coffee grounds
- Tea bags
- Bread
- Meat
- Cheese
- Rice
- Vegetable and fruit scraps
- Indoor plant leaf clippings

GENERAL WASTE BIN

Place all general waste and recyclable containers in this bin, including:

- Plastic and metal containers and bottles, including takeaway containers and milk bottles
- Disposable coffee cups
- Packaging, such as chip packets or food wrapping
- Stationery, such as pens, ring binders or CDs
- Plastic bags

There are separate bins for specialist items such as **batteries**, **e-waste**, **Styrofoam**, **cartridges** and **construction waste** around the University. General Waste is sorted off-site into recyclable and non-recyclable materials.

PAPER RECYCLING BIN

Place all paper products in this bin, including:

- Plain and coloured paper
- Gloss paper
- Shredded paper
- Envelopes
- Paper folders
- Dividers and document wallets
- Cardboard boxes
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Books
- Cardboard

NOTE: dirty food wrappings should be placed into red bins.
