While a significant number of scholarships are offered to future students embarking on their tertiary studies, UTS also has a strong focus on rewarding our current students progressing through the different stages of their degree.

SCHOLARSHIP PROFILES

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ELITE SCHOOL LEAVERS

UTS offers a range of prestigious high-value scholarships to recognise and reward high-achieving school leavers commencing an undergraduate degree at UTS.

Through these scholarships we aim to create opportunities for students to nurture innovation and inspire change so you can become the leaders of tomorrow!

These scholarships include the:

- > Vice-Chancellor's Outstanding Achievement Scholarship – ATAR of 95.0 and above
- > Vice-Chancellor's Merit Scholarship – ATAR of 90.0 and above with demonstrated financial disadvantage
- > Business Dean's Scholarship – ranked in ATAR order
- > Engineering & Information Technology Dean's Scholarship – ATAR of 95.0 and above
- > Health Dean's Scholarship – ranked in ATAR order
- > Law Dean's Scholarship – ATAR of 98.0 and above
- > Science Dean's Scholarship – ATAR of 99.0 and above
- > Science High Achievers Scholarship – ATAR of 95.0 and above

Students must have a UAC preference to a UTS undergraduate course at the time of ATAR release to be considered. An optional application form is available on the Scholarships website, which we recommend you submit, to give you a competitive edge.

You will find additional details about each of these scholarships listed on the UTS Scholarships table.

DIVERSITY ACCESS SCHOLARSHIP

UTS offers the Diversity Access Scholarship (DAS) program to assist students from low socio-economic backgrounds who may also be experiencing other forms of educational disadvantage, to achieve their educational goals.

This scholarship is available to undergraduate, postgraduate and research students, and is valued at between \$500 and \$2,500 per session, with a maximum duration of two sessions. UTS frequently offers over 500 Diversity Access scholarships each year.

Both current and future students are eligible to apply for a DAS, and if you remain eligible, you can re-apply and receive this scholarship more than once during the course of your studies at UTS.

Selection is determined on a relative needs basis, prioritising applicants who are able to demonstrate multiple educational disadvantages in addition to financial hardship, via a UAC Equity Scholarship application. Equity criteria include:

- > Rural or regional background
- > Sole parent responsibilities
- > Carer responsibilities
- > Long-term medical condition / disability or ongoing effect of abuse
- > Indigenous Australian
- > Refugee background

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INDIGENOUS STUDENTS

UTS provides a number of scholarships specifically for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.

Jumbunna, our Indigenous House of Learning, are committed to raising the status of Indigenous people at UTS and driving UTS's commitment to Indigenous issues, education and employment outcomes. An important part of this approach is collaborating with industry partners, and corporate and community donors to establish scholarships for Indigenous students. These scholarships can include financial support but may also provide the opportunity for overseas travel and work placements.

Scholarships specifically for Indigenous Australians are listed on the UTS Scholarships table under the heading Jumbunna Indigenous House of Learning.

You are also encouraged to check out the broader range of UTS Scholarships and apply for any others you may be eligible for.

UTS ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

The UTS Alumni Scholarship aims to support and recognise the contributions of current UTS undergraduate students who have demonstrated commitment to UTS and the wider community through their involvement in community service activities.

This scholarship is funded by many of our generous UTS Alumni, who wish to support current UTS students to grow, innovate and create.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHICH SCHOLARSHIPS AM I ELIGIBLE FOR?

To determine whether you can apply for a particular scholarship, you need to consider your individual circumstances against the specific eligibility criteria of the scholarship.

Key eligibility criteria to look for are:

- > Future or current student?
- > Your Faculty and/or course?
- > Undergraduate or postgraduate?
- > Academic merit (see below)?
- > Do you meet any of our Equity criteria (see below)?
- > Indigenous Australian?
- > Elite athlete?

ACADEMIC MERIT

For future students - this is determined based on your High School results (ATAR or equivalent), or if applicable, results from prior studies at TAFE or an undergraduate degree at another institution.

For continuing students - this is determined based on the results obtained so far in subjects from your current degree at UTS.

EQUITY CRITERIA

Scholarships with an Equity component are for students who may be encountering additional challenges in accessing tertiary education or who are experiencing other educational disadvantages which make it difficult to succeed at university.

Equity criteria can include:

- > Students experiencing financial hardship*
- > New students relocating from a regional and remote area
- > Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students
- > Students from a refugee background
- > Students with a long term disabilities or medical conditions
- > Sole parents and carers

It is important to note that for many equity-based scholarships you are required to submit an Equity Scholarship application through the Universities

Admissions Centre (UAC). It is a free online application which will allow you to be considered for all applicable UTS Equity Scholarships, and can be completed at any time prior to the UTS scholarship closing date.

*As a rough guide, you are considered to be experiencing financial hardship if you are receiving a means -tested income support payment via Centrelink.

DO I NEED TO APPLY?

In most cases, yes you will need to submit a written application to be considered for a scholarship. However, for a small number of scholarships, recipients are selected based on student data, such as your ATAR.

When an application form is optional, we highly recommend submitting the scholarship application to give yourself a competitive edge.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Most UTS scholarships have an online application form on our website which can be completed in your own time from home. Some scholarships require you to complete more than one form, and if you are applying for an equity-based scholarship you will need to also apply through the UAC Equity Scholarship application process.

WHEN DO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS OPEN / CLOSE?

Scholarship opportunities will open and close throughout the year depending on availability and the academic calendar. Future student scholarship will generally require an application to be submitted before ATARs are released in December each year.

ARE SCHOLARSHIPS DEPENDENT ON ME ENROLLING IN A SPECIFIC COURSE?

Scholarships will either be University-wide, meaning that you can be enrolled in any Faculty across the University, or can be course-dependent and require enrolment in a specific course or discipline area (i.e. mechanical engineering, physics, law etc.)

For course-specific scholarships, you can only be considered for the scholarship if you have the relevant enrolment, or for future students, relevant UAC course application. It is also important to check if you are required to remain enrolled in a specific course area to continue receiving payments, or if course transfers are allowed.

ARE HSC BONUS POINTS TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION IN SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION?

For most commencing student scholarships with a specific ATAR cut off, HSC bonus points are not taken into consideration, only your ATAR (or equivalent) is used.

HOW WILL I FIND OUT IF I HAVE BEEN AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP?

If you have applied for a scholarship, either UAC or the UTS Scholarships Office will contact you to advise you of the outcome. Applicants will be notified after the selection process has been completed, generally 4-6 weeks from the time of the application closing date.

IF I AM OFFERED A SCHOLARSHIP, CAN I DEFER IT?

Unfortunately, unlike a course offer, Scholarship offers cannot be deferred. However, if you would like to take a gap year or have planned leave from your studies you may be able to apply in the following application round. Check your scholarship for more details.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO ENSURE I KEEP MY SCHOLARSHIP?

Nearly all scholarships have strict ongoing eligibility requirements, often related to maintaining a full-time study load and maintaining a certain academic standard.

All information regarding your Scholarship is available in the Conditions of Award provided to you in your Letter of Offer. If your study circumstances change, please contact the Scholarships Office for further advice.

CAN I HOLD MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP SIMULTANEOUSLY?

In most cases no, however some exceptions apply if an equity scholarship is approved based on exceptional circumstances. Please check the specific Conditions of Award at the time of offer.

WHAT IF I AM UNSUCCESSFUL IN OBTAINING A SCHOLARSHIP?

Future student scholarships can be extremely competitive.

If you are unsuccessful for a future student scholarship, there are also plenty of opportunities for current students at UTS. You can apply for scholarships throughout your studies depending on what stage you are at in your degree. Current student scholarships include travel opportunities and internships to enhance your learning experience at UTS.

WILL MY SCHOLARSHIP BE TAXED?

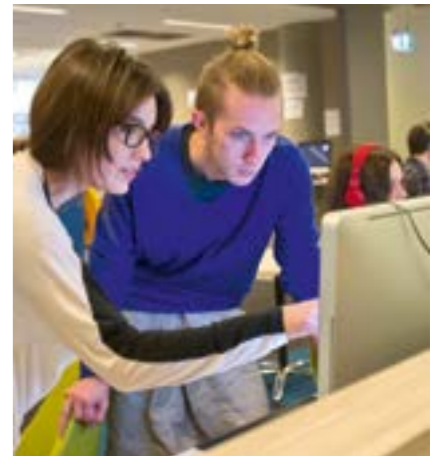


