

UTS Prize Conditions of Award

GroupM Prize for Digital Futures

Faculty: Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. PRIZE NAME: GroupM Prize for Digital Futures

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Prize is to recognise outstanding academic performance of student(s) in the Bachelor of Communication Program enrolled in subject 54065 Digital Futures

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients:

Usually one (1) Recipient will be awarded the Prize at the end of each academic year that the subject 54065 Digital Futures is offered.

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

- The value of the Prize to the Recipient is \$1,000.
- The Recipient will also receive a certificate of award.

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$1,000 by electronic funds transfer to his/her nominated bank account.
- A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences prize-giving event.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Recipient must:

- be enrolled in a UTS award course; and
- have received a result in subject 54065 Digital Futures in the academic year immediately prior to the selection of the Prize; and
- not have had any prior results in this subject.

5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA, IN PRIORITY ORDER

- The prize will be awarded to the student who achieves the highest final result in 54065 Digital Futures.
- In the event more than one student scores the highest final result, the prize will be given to the student with the highest GPA in the Major.

6. SELECTION

The prize will be recommended by the School of Communications. The successful candidate will be approved by the Dean, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.

7. OTHER CONDITIONS

The recipient will send an acknowledgement to the donor upon receipt of the prize.
