

UTS Scholarship Conditions of Award UTS 30th Anniversary Grant for Students from Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below grant ('Grant') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Fee Credit. The administrative processes to support awarding this Scholarship will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. SCHOLARSHIP NAME: UTS 30th Anniversary Grant for Students from Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, and Vietnam

2. PURPOSE

To attract commencing international students from Indonesia and Vietnam to enrol in an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework program at UTS in Sydney.

This Conditions of Award replaces the Conditions of Award UTS 30th Anniversary Grant for Students from Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam approved in November 2017 for students commencing in Spring 2018.

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients

A maximum of 40 new recipients in Spring 2018.

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient

- UTS will pay for AUD\$3,000 towards each Recipient's UTS tuition fees for the course enrolled in for the duration of the Scholarship as defined in clause 4.
- The Scholarship cannot be transferred, deferred or redeemed for cash.

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

- The tuition fee contributions will be made directly to the Recipient's UTS fees account each session for the duration of the Scholarship as defined in clause 4.
- The tuition fee contributions are subject to the Recipient satisfying ongoing eligibility criteria as defined in clause 8.

4. DURATION

The duration of the Grant is one (1) session. Extension of the Grant is not possible.

5. RECIPIENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

An applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

- Must be a citizen of Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand or Vietnam; and
- Must be currently living in or based in Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand or Vietnam; and
- Must be an international student (not an Australian citizen, New Zealand citizen or permanent resident of Australia); and
- Must meet all admission criteria for the undergraduate or postgraduate coursework program at UTS in Sydney; and
- Must be commencing studies in a UTS degree full-time on campus; and
- Must accept their offer (including payment of the deposit required) for the approved UTS program by 30 November 2017 for Autumn session 2018 commencement and 31 May 2018 for Spring session 2018 commencement.
- Must not have completed studies in Australia; and

• Must not be a government sponsored student.

6. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA

Acceptance of UTS course offer (including payment of deposit required) by the specified date as defined in clause 5.

7. SELECTION

UTS International will automatically consider all commencing international students from Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand or Vietnam applying for an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework program at UTS in Sydney. There is no separate application or documentation in addition to what is required for the coursework application.

8. ONGOING RECIPIENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

8.1 UTS Enrolment:

• The Recipient must continue to be enrolled in the eligible UTS program past the census date in the session in which the Grant is granted.

8.3 Leave / Deferral / Course withdrawal:

- All deferral or suspension requests are subject to approval from UTS.
- If the Recipient defers the UTS offer or withdraws from the UTS course, the Grant will be terminated.

8.4 Other obligations and conditions:

- The offer of the Grant is made subject to all information provided by the Recipient being true and accurate.
- By accepting the offer of the Grant, each Recipient agrees to the Conditions of Award.
- Recipients must comply with all of UTS's rules, policies and procedures including those relating to conduct.
- The Recipient is responsible for advising UTS International of any changes in circumstances that would make him/her ineligible for continuation of the Grant, including but not limited to deferring study and changing his/her international student visa status to another visa category, including but not limited to Permanent Residency Visa.
- Any changes to the Recipient's circumstances not addressed by the Conditions of Award will be considered by UTS International on a case-by-case basis.

9. TERMINATION OF RECIPIENT'S FEE CREDIT

The Grant will terminate:

- If the Recipient ceases to meet the eligibility criteria; or
- If the Recipient breaches any conditions of the Grant; or
- If UTS determines that the student is guilty of misconduct and after consultation with the University Secretary the delegate able to award the Grant deems that it is not appropriate for the Recipient to continue to hold the Grant.
