

UTS Prize Conditions of Award Sydney Mechanics' School of Arts Award for Achievement in Adult Education

Faculty: Arts and Social Sciences

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. PRIZE NAME: Sydney Mechanics' School of Arts Award for Achievement in Adult Education

2. PURPOSE

To attract and award those students making significant contributions in the community as adult educators, and achieving high academic performance in their postgraduate academic studies.

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients:

One (1) Recipient will be awarded the Prize at the end of each academic year.

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

- The value of the Prize to the Recipient is \$1000.
- The Recipient will also receive a certificate of award.

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$1000 by electronic funds transfer to his/her nominated bank account; and
- A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the FASS prize-giving event.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Recipient must:

- Be enrolled or completed in the last 6 months in:
 - MA in Applied Linguistics and TESOL(C04305); or
 - MEd Learning & Leadership degree (C04307)
- Have not received this award in the past.

5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA, IN PRIORITY ORDER

- Evidence of exemplary educational practice in adult (post-compulsory) education, including informal education;
- Excellent overall grade point average in their enrolled course.

6. SELECTION

The Prize will be selected by the School of Education Prizes Committee, comprised of:

- Dean or their nominee
- Nominee of the Course coordinator of the MA Applied Linguistics & TESOL
- Nominee of the Course coordinator of the MEd Learning & Leadership

7. OTHER CONDITIONS

Candidates will be required to provide a folio of evidence by a specified date each year. The folio will consist of:

- Current CV
- Academic record

- A supporting statement of no more than 1000 words outlining the candidate's suitability for the award
- 2 letters of recommendation, one from an academic, and one from a professional supervisor
- Appendices: Sample(s) of work from their adult education practice if appropriate
