FOOTNOTES

1. Enrolment for local research students occurs online via **Enrolment**. International research students enrol on campus at the Graduate Research School from the beginning of the enrolment period. Enrolment in coursework subjects is online and must be completed by the last day to enrol for the session in which the subject commences.

2. Information about the application and closing dates for all scholarships is available via **Scholarships**.

3. HECS-FEEHELP, FEE-HELP, local award, and international fee payment information is available via **Fees and Payment**. Full financial liability applies after the census dates. For onshore and offshore census dates and details for all teaching sessions, see **Academic year dates**.

4. Dates for the release of 2019 HSC results are available from **NSW Government HSC** and for the release of ATARs are available from **UAC**.

5. Census dates for research degree students are later in the year for Autumn and Spring sessions due to the flexible start dates for these students at UTS. Full financial and local liability applies after these **census dates**.

6. **Census date:** Last day to withdraw from a subject without incurring academic penalty and financial liability.

7. **Mid-session StuVac (Study vacation):**
Includes: one day on which formal classes may be scheduled to make up for those missed due to public holidays or University emergencies in the first half of the teaching session; activity-based learning such as field trips, etc.
Students must be advised of these activities at the beginning of the teaching session as part of the subject outline.
Does not include: formal classes; assessment submission deadline; examinations.
Students on professional experience placements do not participate in StuVac.

8. **Final StuVac (Study vacation):**
Includes: one day on which formal classes may be scheduled to make up for those missed due to public holidays or University emergencies in the second half of the teaching session; non-compulsory review/revision sessions for students.
Does not include: formal classes; assessment deadlines.
Students must not introduce any new material in this week (with the exception of the catch-up class scheduled due to public holidays or University emergencies).
Students on professional experience placements do not participate in StuVac.
